JOHN HENRY FAUST

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN I John Henry Faust of the State of South Carolina do hereby being very sick and weak of Body but of Perfect Mind and Memory thanks be to God for it Do make and ordain this my last will and Testament Principally and first of all I give and bequeath my Soul to God that gave it and my body to the dust Nothing doubting but I shall receive the Same again at the General resurrection by the Mighty Power of God And as touching My Worldly Est- I dispose of them in Manner and Form following. Viz. First I give and bequeath my Land to My two Sons Jesse and Moses to be Equally divided between them But my loving Wife Dorothy enjoying the third of Said Land during her Natural life Secondly, I give and bequeath to my loving Wife the third of All my Estate that may in any wise be mine during her natural Life Also I give and bequeath to my wife and Children Equally all dues that is or may be Due to Me left by my Father Deceased Also I give and bequeath to my Wife and Children (My Wife Drawing her thirds during her Life) that Debt Due to Me By the Publick for my Land to be equally Divided amongst my Children. My Wife to Draw the third of the Stock the rest to be Equally Divided amongst the Children I also Make and Ordain My loving Wife the Sole Executor of this My last Will and Testament Revoking Disannulling and Disallowing all former wills of Gifts whatsoever by Me heretofore Made do make and ordain this and no other to be my last will and Testament In witness where of I have hereunto
