I George Lightner Sr. of the State and District aforesaid being very infirm in body, and of sound and disposing mind (praise be to God) do make this my last will and Testament-- after Commending my soul into the hands of God who gave it.--I will that my body be decently and religiously interred- and in view of death make the following disposition of the earthly substance which it has pleased God to bless me with Viz.----Imprimis I will and bequeath to my beloved son Elias the plantation on which I live, the Souter Colt together with the following Slaves Viz. Gin Marin, Milford Mary, Bill and Horace, also a Bed and furniture -- To my beloved Son-in-law Daniel D. Finley I give ~~the~~ following Slaves Viz. Phillis, Marie, James, Elyah and Bill To my beloved Son George I give the Slave Daniel--- It is my will that the balance of my effects be sold and after the payment of my lawful debts should any thing remain that it be equally divided between my Children --- I do hereby appoint my Son George Lightner and Daniel D. Finley the Executors of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and Seal this 25th day of May in the year of our Lord 1832
