Branch which was conveyed to me by Godfrey Keller also a negro
Boy named July about fourteen years of Age; also about Eighteen
acres of Land the remainder of the Tract of Twenty two acres
conveyed to me by James S. Guignard and also about Twenty five
Acres of Land being the Residue of Remainder of the Tract
granted to Peter Keller say all of said Tract that I now own ly-
ing on the west side of the Main Road leading to Columbia and
is adjoing the Land conveyed to me by James S. Guignard just
above described also two work Horses Also one small Waggon and
Geer - two Plows and Geer my Household and Kitchen Furniture-
four Cows and Calves (say eight head) and the one half of my
stock of Hogs to her for and during the term of her natural
life and no longer Item after the death of my said wife I give
devise and bequeath the whole of the above property to such
Child or Children as may be born of my said wife during my
intermarriage with her to him her or their heirs and assigns
forever. or to the survivor thereof or survivors share and share
alike- And should there be no lawful issue during my present
Marriage or in case there should be and they die before they
attain the Age of twenty one, then and in such Case it is my will
wish and desire that all the property devised to my said Wife
shall belong to my grand Sons, George Hughes son of Isaac Hughes
John Smith son of Thomas Smith and the eldest son of my Son
