JOHN GILL

In the Name of God Amen.

I John Gill of Mercer County State of Virginia Kentucky district do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament as follows- That Plantation on which my family now resides at the head of Griffs Run I leave wholly and solely to my beloved wife Margaret Gill and to her Heirs forever- All the rest and residue of my Estate real and personal must be sold and after paying my just debts be equally divided amongst my children share and share alike and in case my wife should bear me a posthumous Child then and in that case the said Child shall be entitled to an equal share of my Estate with my other Children - and my will is that my Executors in Carolina shall at thier discretion sell and dispose of my property in this State and remit the proceeds to my Executors in Kentucky or send the property there as to them shall seem best. And I do constitute and appoint my Brother William Gill and John and Thomas Pitman my Executors in Kentucky and William Bishop, Richard Ellis and Robert Lithgow my Executors in SeCarolina witness my hand this 25th day of September 1788
