5th. One Feather bed and furniture to him and his Heirs
and should he die without a lawful Heir the said property

is to return to John C. Sturgeon Jun'r all of which shall
be to the Disposal and Guardian Ship of John C Sturgeon
Jun'r with the care and Guardian Ship of my son thomas
Sturgeon as above untill he comes of age when all the a-
bove property shall be delivered unto him without resent-
tation whatever and I give unto my sister Mary Carters
Daughter Susan Carter One feather bed one side Saddle and
all my wareing apparel to her and her lawful Issue and in
case she should die without an Issue of her body the said
property is to return to the said thomas Sturgeon

Also I give to my brother thomas Carter one dollar to Hen-
ry Carter one dollar and to my Sister Dorcas Haslum One
dollar of lawful money of this State to be paid to them
by my executors and I also do appoint John C. Sturgeon
and William Sturgeon Jun'r my Executors of this my last
will and testament hereby revoking all former wills be
made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my my hand and
seal this 8th day of April in the year Of our lord 1824
