ing her Natural Life at her death to go to the Lawful Heirs
of John T. Killings them and their Heirs Forever to be
Equally divided between Such as Sall be Living I give t o
My Sister Awsey Hinton Five dollars to be paid her or her
heirs by My representatives also to My Brother Granvill
Thompsons^h Children Five dollars E. My Brother Legran Thom-
pson two Children^h that is to Say William Thompson Five dollars
and Marthe Bunch Five dollare E. also to be paid by My
Executors--

I Give to My Neice Caroline Williams five Negrows Namely Martha Amey Dempsey Moses Little Mary them and their In-
areas forever to her and her Heirs and assigns forever--

I also give to William Gaffney and Charlot his wives Child-
ren Namely Elizabeth Gaffney Ely William Gaffney Caroline
Gaffney Children of the above Named William and Charlot
Gaffney Twelve Hundred dollars to be paid out of My Estate
in Cash to be paid by the Legateese in proportion Namely
John E. Williams Caroline Williams Mary Killingsworth Allen
Gibson and Mary Gibsons Children and Willim Gaffney is to
Act as Gardeene for his Children by appointnt-of me the

Testator. Also I give to Jorden Gay one Little Molato

Child Named Matilda to be delivered to him the said Gay

when the Child becomes Twelve Years old or at the disc-
