I Item It is my will and desire that all my just debts & funeral Charges be first paid, Item I give and bequeath all my Real and personal Estate to be Equally divided between John Holliday and Harriet Holliday, son & Daughter of William and Mary Holliday to them & the heirs of thier body forever, but if Either of them should Die before they have an heir so as to my desire that the other should have the whole of the Estate, and if they both should die without Issue it is my desire that it shall be Equally Divided between Daniel Holliday's Eldest Daughter Sarah Holliday, and James Terry's Eldest Daughter Mary Terry and lastly I do hereby appoint my beloved friends Daniel Holliday & Ethel Heath my Lawfull Execut to Execute this my last will and testament, Ratifying & Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th Day of April Anno Domini 1796 signed sealed published pronounced & Declared in presence Of
