It is my desire that all my just Debts be settled in an honest upright Manner-- I appoint Richard Bolan and Maurice Murphy my true and lawful Executors----- The Residue & Remainder of my Estate I leave to John Silver he to possess and demand all Debts, dues, and Demands-
