to take good care of my faithful Negro Woman Hagar, and to treat her well and I desire that she shall be set free free by my said Heir and Executor, if it be possible to do so legally, but if it shallbe impossible to do so, then my desire is that she shall wever be put to work as a slave but that she shall be supplied by my said Heir and Executor with a plentiful support of good and wholesome provisions and clothes, and that she be permitted to dispose of her time in such manner as she may think proper. And I further more direct my said Heir and Executor to pay to the said Hagar yearly and every year during her life the sum of Twenty Dollars, to be disposed of as she may think proper in providing extra articles of Clothing and Food for herself it being my desire that she shell never suffer for any of the necessaries of Life. And I do furthermore direct that the said Hagar shall have for her own use and benefit the whole of my Household and Kitchen furnature. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this Eighth day of August in the year of our Lord 1825 and in the fiftieth year of the Sovereignty and Independ ence of the United States Of America.
