Hermon' my negro property- upon the intermarriage of my wife; I desire distributed as far as practicable, pursuant, to directions herein before given- I commit my children to the maternal care of my beloved wife, the proper education of whom, I enjoin upon her, as an object, of paramount impartance. The incidental expences, of education. I direct paid from the products of my farm or otherwise, as may be found most convenient --- Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my Friends Dan Gradick, Jasper Coon and C. Bookter Exts - of this my last will and Testament hereby revokeing and makeing void all former wills and Legacies I have hereunto set my by me heretofore made.
