I William Hinson of Richland County and State of South Carolina. being in perfect health of Body and of perfect mind and Memory, thanks be given unto God, calling unto Mind and Memory the Mortality of my Body, and Knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to die; do make and direct this my last Will and testament that is to say principally and First of all I give and recommend my Soul unto the hand of Almighty God. that I give it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth. to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executor nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such Worldly - Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this Life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form- First I give and bequeath unto Mary Hinson my beloved Daughter my negro Girl Sally and the residue of my personal Estate to be sold by my Executors for Cash. and the AMOUNT to be appropriated for the maintainance of my said Daughter, the overplus to be paid unto her when she shall come of Lawfull age, and it is my desire that my Executors shall sue for the Recovery of mine & Hannah Dudley part of her Fathers Estate. and that Jacob Killingworth and John Killingworth be Witnesses and that a Bond now in the possession of Forecupine being part of the Estate aforesaid be sued for in the like manner . and appropriated as above mentioned. together with the produce of what is recovered from the Estate of the Father of Hannah Dudley .
