In the Name of God Amen I Samuel Jackson being Sick in Body but of good and Perfect memory, I thus Be to Almighty God, and calling to Remembrance the uncertain state of this Transitory life and that all flesh must yield unto Death when it shall please God to call do make this my Last will and Testament in manner and form following. First being penitent and sorry for all my Sins most humbly Desiring forgiveness of the Same I commend my soul unto Almighty God my Saviour and Redeemer in whom and by whose merits I trust and Believe assuredly to be saved and to have full remission and forgiveness of all my Sins and to inherit the kingdom of heaven, and my body I commit to the Earth, to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter named and for the Settling of my temporal Estate and such Good Chattels and Debts as it hath pleased Almighty God bestow upon me. I give and Dispose in the manner and form following- I give and bequeath unto my son Arnold the Gray mare and the Barrell Colt and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto Chas Jagner and his heirs for ever one Likely young cow and Colt-

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly and her heirs for ever the Black Mare -Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Betsy and her heirs for ever the black mare's colt- And all the Past and Residue of my Real and Personal Estate I give and Bequeath unto my well beloved wife Agnus Jackson during her Natural Life and at her Decease to be Equally Divided amongst all my children, only the Bay Mare to Belong to Arnold my Son and his heirs for Ever and I Do hereby nominate a appoint my true and Trusty friend William Fox to be Executor to this my last will and testament and I do hereby Revoke all other will or Wills that I have made acknowledging this to be my Last
