and State of South Carolina being in sound mind memory and
understanding thanks be to God and being conscious of the uncer-
tainty of human life do make and ordain this my last Will and
testament revoking all other heretofore by me made Imprimis
I Will and devize that my body be decently buried at the
discretion of my Executors.---Item I Will and desire that all
my just debts be paid. I do give to my beloved son John B.
Hall one dollar and the part of his mothers Estate from Wm.
Kelly his grandfather-- This my will that my beloved Wife
Sarah Hall shall have a maintainence one of my estate during
her widowhood.--- I do give to my beloved daughter Celina
McSwain One hundred dollars and the remaining part of her mother
Estate from her grandfather Wm. Kelly. This my will and desire
that the rest and residue of my Estate be kept together for the
use of my four children children that the same shall be equally
divided among them when they marry or arrive at the age of
twenty one years but should my said four children named Polly,
Sarah Prudence and Jane die without heirs of their bodies then
the Estate shall survive to the survivors and that the joint
tenancy shall never be dissolved but shall continue forever
while trees grows and waters runs and I do appoint my trusty
friend Claiborn Clifton, Thos. Heath and John J. Chappell
Executors of this my last will and testament. In witness where

in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
two.
