

I James McCawley of the County Tyrone Ireland finding myself perfectly well and sound in recollection, but Sick in Body and wishing to settle my Worldly affairs do dispose of them in the following manner I leave unto William Hearn as a County man not having Relations or Heirs to leave it to the Money of Mine in Colonel John Crayens hands amounting to between two and three Hundred Dollars - say two Hundred & twenty one and ninety one Cents - I also leave and bequeath unto the said William Hearn a Note of mine in the Said Colonel John Crayens hands on John Loyd Six Miles below Granby, amounting to one Hundred Dollars, payable on the Sixth day of January eighteen Hundred and Twenty - if it may be Gods will to take me away, I will that I shall be decently buried - done this Twenty Sixth day of October one Thousand eight Hundred and Nineteen - in the presence of us -

N.B. I will that this my last will and Testament shall hold good in favour of the said William Hearn for a Term of Five years
