In the first place it is my Will and desire that all my Just and lawful debts be paid out of the proceeds of my Estate-- and afterwards. I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my property to my Dear Children -Viz Jane, James and George D. McClellan and I appoint and nominate as Executors of this my last Will and Testament my friends Andrew Wallace and Benjamin Harrison Junior. In witness my hand and Seal in presence of John Wyche Zachariah Phillips Daniel Dookery this the 4 Dec. 1817. Jas. McClellan
