After all my just Debts are paid I give devise and bequeath unto my Brother--John A Reese my Negro woman named Hannah and her Six children namely Wade, Mariah, Alken Dartriss, Venus and Easter to him and his heirs forever provision being made by the Will of my Father for the Distribution of the property given me by him and I do nominate constitute and appoint my Said Brother John A Reese Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making Void all and every other Will or Wills at any time heretofore by me made and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Jesse Reese have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Seventh day of January-- Eighteen Hundred and nineteen.
