2nd. I will and bequeath to my Aunt Mary Archibald Fifty
Dollar and to my two uncles Hugh Archibald and Robert Archi-
bald each Fifty Dollars- I will and bequeath to my beloved
mother one half of the residue of all my effects after paying
the foregoing Legacys -to be placed in the hands of Hugh
Archibald and Robert Archibald for my said mother Margret
Stevens for own use and bennifit and to be paid over to her
by the said Hugh and Robert Archibald as her wants may re-
quire. I also will and bequeath to my tow nephews John
and Robert Stenens Two hundred Dollars each. I also will
and bequeath to my Sister Margret Perry and familey all the
residue or ballance of my effects whatever they maybe after
paying the legacys Named in the foregoing Clauses of this
my last will and Testament. And I do hereby empower and
require my executor to Sell my watch and chain Tank and Cloth-
ing and anything else he can find that belongs to me to
collect all debts due to me in any way and to pay over to
the persons named their Shares as set forth in the foregoing
clause.

3rd. I do hereby constitute and apoint James Cathcart of the
Town of Columbia to be my Lawfull Executor to exicute this
my last will and Testament as witness my hand and Seal this
