Nancy Elizabeth Mary Josse Jinny and Martha the Said Negros is to Continue in the family other wise the Said three Negros is to be Sold and one equal division made among the Said Children Nancy Elizabeth Mary Jesse Jinny and Marthavof the whole It is further my will and wish and I do hereby Constitute and appoint my loving Son in Law John McLean and Nancy Kill* ingsworth my daughter the Soal Executor and executrix of this my Last will and Testament#2 JESSE KILLINGSWORTH.
