

In the Name of God Amen I Jesse Killingsworth of the State South Carolina and district of Richland being very Sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given to God and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed to all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the Same by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estates wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give dismiss and dispose of the Same in the following manner and form: Viz-----

And 1st. It is my will and wish that a Sum Sufficient to discharge all my just debts be raised and levied out of my Estate by my Executors and appropriated to that use-----

2. it is my wish that all my land Cattle Hogs Sheep Horses waggon plantation tools riding Chair and Harness House and Kitchen furniture (except five featherbeds which I give and bequeath unto my loving Children Nancy Mary Jesse Jinney and Martha Killingsworths) be Sold at publick Auction and the money arising from Said Sale after the debts is paid is to be put in with the value of three Negros Caty Kis and Easter which is to be valued by two disinterested men provided there can be an Equal division made among my Six Children Viz. Nancy Elizabeth Mary Jesse Jinny and Martha the Said Negros is to Continue in the family other wise the Said three Negros is to be Sold and one equal division made among the Said Children Nancy Elizabeth Mary Jesse Jinny and Martha of the whole--- It is further my will and wish and I do hereby Constitute and appoint my loving Son in Law John McLean and Nancy Killingsworth my daughter the Soal Executor and exequitrix of this my Last will and Testament----

and I do hereby disallow revoke and disannull all and every other former wills Legacies and bequeaths by me in any wise before named Willed orbequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I the Said Jesse Killingsworth have hereunto Set my hand and affixed my Seal this 19th day of June in the year of our Lord 1818-----
