furnerture I do also give and bequeath unto my three Sons  
Isaac John Johathon my plantation and land after her widow-  
hood I do also give and bequeath to my Daughter Zely one  
bed and furnerture also a cow also my daughter Hannah one  
bed and furnerture and one Cow with one horn I do also  
give and bequeath to my Daughter Rachel one bed and Cow  
and bed furnerture I do also give and bequeath to my Daugh-  
ter Polley one bed and furnerture and one Cow I do also  
give and bequeath to my three sons Isaac John Jonathan one  
bed and furnerture a peace and one Cow to each also one  
bay hors name Jack to John---- Also one ox to Jonathan--  
I also give and bequeth to all my Children equal devesion  
after my wife widohood I give and bequeath the same to my  
said beloved wife Hannah who I hereby appoint only Ex-  
ecutrix of this my last will and testament I also make my  
son Isaac an Exeter, to assist his mother in witness where-  
of I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal the 29 Janeary in  
the year of our Lord----1825---
