this my last will and testament in manner and form following
that is to say 1st. I give and devise all my house hold and
plantation tools and stock of every kind and negroes also
my tract of Land on which I now reside to belong to my
loving wife Ebbelino Graddick during her natural life or
widowhood, If my beloved wife wishes or desires to sell the
Land or any other portion of the property she is at liberty
to do so at public outcry at her pleasure.

2. And if it should so happen that my wife should marry,
that it is my will that all my property to be sold, and my
wife to have one third part of the proceeds, and the other
two thirds to be equally divided, between my children
Charlotte D. E. Graddick, Christain J. F. Graddick, Whit-
field D. D. Graddick-- Elias B. L. Graddick and it is my
will that my wife should assist my children as they become
of age or marry all she can in Justice to herself and the
rest of the children and I do hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my beloved wife Ebelino Graddick executrix and David
Graddick executors of this my last will and testament here-
by revoking and making void all former wills and testaments at
any time heretofore by me made and do declare this to be my
last will and Testament in witness whereof I have subscribed
my hand and Seal this November 8th 1847.
