~~but in perfect mind and memory~~, do make and ordain the fol-
lowing to be my last will Testament that is to say first -

I desire that all my just debts be paid by my ~~Executor here-~~

after to be named- Secondly I give and bequeath unto Mrs.

Priscilla Darrington of Saint Thomas's my Negroe man Sam

during ~~the~~ natural life, and after her decease, It is will

and desire that he shall then be free and at his own disposal-

I give unto my friend John Erringham the Sum of five pounds

Sterling, also to my friend Thomas Fitzpatrick the like sum

of five pounds and lastly I give unto Mrs. Ann Singleton

Widow of the High Hills of Santee all the residue of my Estate

both Real and personal to her and her Heirs for ever - Save only

five pounds to my friend Robert Weston, and do nominate and

appoint my trusty friend John Erringham above named the Sole ex-

~~ecutor of this my last will~~ do hereby re-

voked all former wills and Testaments and acknowledge this only to be

my last will and Testament, In witness whereof I hereunto set

my hand and seal this Ninth day of December 1796-
