my last will and Testament In Manner & form following (that
is to say) After paying all my Just and lawfull debts. I
Give and bequeath unto my dear and beloved wife Mary Seay
all my Estate both Real & personal (to Witt), my Lands, Ne-
groes hogs horses, plantation tools and all the other Cha-
tels that I Now possess during her Natural life and at her
death to dispose of all my property as She May Deem proper
to divide amongst my Children & Grandchildren. And Lastly,
I appoint my beloved wife Mary Seay Sole Executrix of this
my last will and Testament, hereby Revoking all former Wills
by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand
& Seal this 3'd Day of October Anno Domini 1828
