RICHLAND DISTRICT) IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. This is the last will and Testament of John Suling. I hereby devise to John Neuffer the eldest Son of John Neuffer all that Square of Land in the Town of Columbia containing four Acres bounded Indigo, Lower, Gates and Assembly Street conveyed to me by James S Guignard Commissioner of Columbia to him the said Neuffer Junior his Heirs and assigns forever I bequeath to the said John Neuffer son of John Neuffer a note of hand for Three hundred and fifty dollars executed to me by Dr. Robert W. Gibbes on the 27 January 1841-- I devise and bequeath to John Neuffer the Son of John Neuffer all the rest of my estate real and personal of whatsoever the same may consist to him his heirs and assigns forever. It is my will and desire that the said John Neuffer Son of John Neuffer shall pay to his sister Caroline Neuffer the sum of one hundred Dollars within one year after my decease, and that this legacy shall constitute a charge upon my whole estate bequeathed and devised to him as aforesaid. I constitute John Neuffer Senior sole Executor of this my last will and testament Sealed with my seal and executed this 28th. July 1842-
