Item- All my personal estate all my goods and Chattles of every decreation, I give and bequeath to my Brother Thos H. Trapp, to him and his heirs forever.-----

Lastly- I hereby nominate and appoint my Uncle Thos C. Trapp Executor to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other wills by me heretofore made declaring this and no other to be my last will.-- -----

Wit- Witness my hand and Seal this 18th day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Seven -----
