to be Equally divided between my wife Lucretia Threewits and my above named Children share and share alike, and that the whole of my Estate remain in the possession of my wife until the youngest Child marrys or arrives to the age of twenty one years and to be managed by my executors to be hereafter mentioned in the most advantageous way for the enteres of my above named wife & Children and the profits arising from my said Estate as given to be disposed of in the following Manner, viz, to Educate my Children as above named or such of them as may not have their Education and for their support. should my wife Marry before my youngest Child arrives of age then and in that Case I wish and desire her to take the share so allotted to her, and that my above named Children shall then have the power to choose their Guardain should they think it expedient so to do. I further desire that should any one of the above named persons Die before they arrive of age or at any other time before their is a distribution of said Estate I then desire their portion of said Estate to go to their Children if they have any and if they have none then to be equally divided amongst the above named persons Equally.-----
