Hogs etc. During her natural life to be too her use Like-
wise I bequeath unto my Son Daniel Martin one Dollar Also
I bequeath unto my son Joseph Martin's Wife Trinity one
Dollar Also to my son James Martin the sum of one Dollar
Also to my son Benjamin Martin the sum of one Dollar Also
to my son Joel Martin the sum of One Dollar Also to my son
Josiah Martin the sum of One Dollar Also my Daughter Nancy
Smith the sum of One Dollar Also to my Daughter Mary Smith
One Cow and Calf Also to my son Aaron Martin I give and be-
queath all my Old tract of land calling for one hundred and
fifty acres whereon I lived to him at the Decease of his
mother and if he the said Aaron is not to distose of the
same to any person if any of the legatees are desirable to
purchase the same from him Also I give and bequeath unto
my Moses one hundred and fifty of land being in the fork of
Gills Creek and that he is not to Sell the same unto any
person if any of the legatees are Desirous to purchase at
the Death of his Mother but the said Aaron and Moses is not
to have any claim to the said lands untill the disease of
their Mother's And at the Disease of my Wife Johanna Martin
I do bequeath all of my Stock of horses neat Cattle, Hogs
etc likewise all my Household and citchen furniture with
all the farming utencills to be appraised and Sold and to
be eaqually Devided between my Daughters Elizabeth Martin
