ALEXANDER KELLY

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN. I Alexander Kelly, of the State of South Carolina, planter, being very sick and weak of Body, but of perfect Mind and Memory, Thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to die do make and ordain my last Will and Testament. That is to say principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul into the Hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Friends, nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again, by the mighty power of God. And as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise, and dispose of the same in the following Manner and form. I give and bequeath to my well beloved friend Burrel Faust, one bay mare, one pld Cow and Calf, nine head of Hogs, one saddle and bridle, and pair of plaited Spurs one pair of Shoes, one pair of fustian Breeches, a great Coat, and a pair of Stockings. I likewise constitute make and ordain the said Burrel Faust and Jasper Faust Ju'r Executors of this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests, and Executors, by me in any Way before named, Willed and bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this, and no other, to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and Ninety two and in the sixteenth year of American Independence
