CHRISTIAN KINGSLER

in the name of God Amen, I Christian Kinsler of the state of South Carolina Camden District Richland County, being in perfect health of body mind and memory thanks be given unto God calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to Die. do make and ordain this my last will and testament. as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless in this life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form. First I give my Son Daniel Kenosler, three hundred acres of Land being two tracts adjoining lying on broad River on the north side in Camden District.

I give my Son John Jacob Kinsler four hundred acres of Land being four tracts adjoining lying in Camden District where I now dwell.

I give my Son Jeremiah Kinsler three hundred and nine teen acres of Land being two tracts adjoining lying on the north side of broad River on Grain Creek in Camden District.

I give my Son Andrew Kinsler two hundred and sixty-five acres of Land being two tracts adjoining lying on the waters of little Grain Creek and big Grain Creek on the north side of broad River in Camden District. I give also to my two Sons Jeremiah and Andrew Kinsler two hundred and fifty-nine acres of Land to be divided equally between them lying on the north side of broad River on the cross roads from Shivers ferry to Sees Mill. I give my Daughter Dorothy Kinsler five Cows and Calves. I give my wife Susanna Kinsler two Negro girls named Jenny and Jude; till her decease and after her decease these two Negro girls and their increase to fall to my heirs.

Also I give my wife Susanna Kinsler five Cows and Calves, such as she will chuse and one riding creature such as She will chuse. Also bedding, pewter, pots, knives, forks, wheels, and other household furniture such as is necessary for family use.

I order all my other Estate both Negroes and Stock etc to be sold
