behoof for evir. Thirdly I leave and bequeth unto my Dearly
beloved Wife Barbra Libecap during During her natural life
time, all and singurlar my my Lands and Tennements of real
and Personal Estate by her to be freely enjoyed and poss'ed
as long as she lives and after her death to be left in the
following manner, that is to say, I leave and bequeth unto the
Childeren of my beloved friend Alexander Bell. that he now
has or have. by my Dearly beloved Daughter. Elizabeth Bell
his present wife. All and singular my Lands. mesagges and
Tenements with all my real and personal Estate to be equally
divided among them and by them to be freely Enjoyed and

last Will and Testament. Eaetly I hereby Ordain and appoint,

and I disere they will have me Burried in the Nursery at the
lower end of my Garden and a Brick wall Build round the same
as soon as possible after my Death, I hereby acknowledge
this and no other to be my last will and Testament, and I
hereby disalow, revoke and disanull any former will or
Testament Legesie or Legacies by me left or bequeth'd formerly
and this and no other to be my last will and Testament. As
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seale this
fiftenth day of Dec. in the yeareof our Lord One thousand
seven hundred and Ninty and 14 th Year of the Independency of
the United States of Ameria.
