The Last Will and Testament of Martin Marshall

In the Name of God Amen. I Martin Marshall Planter of the and in the District aforesaid considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of Sound Mind and Memory thanks be to Almighty God for the Same do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the manner and form following. Item 1st. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Marshall the following Negroes to witt, Old Frank Phillis Daniel and their Increase forever also Hagar Lucey & Crease children of Phillis together with their Increase to her her Heirs or assigns forever. Item 2nd. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne Edmunds the Wife of Rob't Edmunds the following Negroes viz Isaac and a Negro woman named Jude with her Increase and my Negro man called Sampter to her and her her heirs forever. Item 3. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Reese Wife of Jo's Reese the following Negroes to Wit. Winney her child Peter and Melissy and their future increase to her and her heirs forever -- Item 4th. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Vinson the widow of John Vinson a Negro woman and her increase named Thamer. Item 5th. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Emma Caroline Marshall the following Negroes viz Scipio, Milly Betsey & William together with their increase to her and her and her heirs or assigns forever. Item 6. All the Negroes which have come by my Daughter Mary Kirkland I wish to be equally devided with my Own Share between each and every of my Daughters Item 7th. I give unto my Daughter Rebecca H. Thompson the following Negroes Celah, Frank to her and her bodily heirs forever. It is my will and desire that my Landed Estate in manner and form following viz To my Daughter Sarah Marshall I give and bequeath my Dwelling House out Houses and all the lands lying in the boundaries hereinto described Viz Beginning on the North line of Evans

grant to run Somewhat East or South by a hickory tree
Standing in the corner of my fence on the Road leading
from Columbia to McCords ferry a Small pine in the field
a Short distance east of a large persimon Tree which two
Trees the hickory and Pine are to govern the line when run
out which course is to continue direct untill it interseates
with the lower or South line of a tract granted to Samuel
Loque all the Lands lying between this line and the East
line of Evans and Loque both inclusive extending a cross
Cedar Creek and from the the North line of Evans to the
South line of Loques including a part of both tracts be
the Same more or less I give to my daughter Sarah Marshall
to her her heirs and assigns forever - Also it is my Will
and desire that all the rest of my Lands be equally divided
between my Daughters anne Edmunds, Jane Reese Martha Vin-
son Emma C. Marshall and Rebecca H. Thompson Share and
Share alike to them and ther heirs and assigns forever to
be divided according to the valuation of my Executors or
Such persons whom they may See fit to choose for that
purpose. It is my desire that my two half acre Lotts in
the town of Columbia Shall be Sold and the Profits arising
therefrom to be in the first place applied to the payments
of my Debts and the balance if any to be equally divided
among the whole of my children I wish also that my Daughter
Sarah & Emma Should have and I give them Say to Sarah a
mane mule called Nancy Willow and to Emma a Horse mule cal-
led Murph also all my house hold and Kitchen furniture I
give to my Said Daughters Sarah & Emma Marshall the balance
of my Stock of all descriptions not above mentioned I wish
to be Sold and the proceeds thereof to be divided among
the whole of my children I furthermore give to my Daughter
Sarah Marshall my Grey Horse and Gig also my waggon and
gears and plantation tools --

And I do hereby appoint my Daughter Sarah Marshall Executrix

and Rob^t Edmunds Executor and James Hopkins also to this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all other Wills by me hereto fore made
