

I Mary Holliday of the Town of Columbia being weak in body but of Sound and disposing mind and memory thanks be to God for the same do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following

Item 1. I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Glaze a female Slave named Jane to her during the term of her natural life and after her death to the lawful heirs of her body

Item 2. I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Sarah Glaze a female Slave named Amy to her during the term of her natural life and after her death to the lawful heirs of her body

Item 3 It is my will that the two legacies above mentioned be given up to my said Grand Children respectively as they become of age say twenty one years or marriage and in mean while my Daughter Mary is to have the use of said Slaves and should either of my said Grand Daughters die leaving no child or children then the property so left to them or either of them shall be considered as part of the residue of my Estate & be appropriated accordingly

Item 4. I give devise and bequeath unto my friends John Veal and Thomas Wells the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal as Trustees Nevertheless and to and for the uses and trusts following that is to say in trust that they shall permit my Daughter Mary the wife of James D Glaze to have the use benefit and behoof of the same, as well as the management thereof for and during the term of her natural life, and which is not to be subject to or liable for the present or future debts of her present or future husband with power and authority at the request of my said Daughter to sell and dispose of any part thereof provided the proceeds of such Sale be appropriated in the Same manner and upon and for the Said trusts and uses hereinbefore or here-

inafter expressed and after the death of my said Daughter the said rest and residue of my Estate is to be disposed of in such manner as my said Daughter shall by her last will and Testament or any other sealed Instrument of writing shall direct . and should my said Daughter die without making any disposition thereof, in such case it is then my will and desire that the said rest and residue of my Estate shall revert and belong to my Grand Children to wit the said Elizabeth and Sarah and John Glaze - David Glaze, Henry Glaze and Martha Glaze and as well to any other child or children which may hereafter be born of my said Daughter share and share alike to them or to the Survivors or Survivor of them his, her or their heirs forever - and should either of them die leaving lawful Issue, that Issue to be entitled to its Parents share.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my Said friends John Veal and Thomas Wells Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other wills by me at any time heretofore made declaring this and no other to be my last.
