

In the Name of God Amen, I Mary Howell Widow of Robert Howell of Richland District and State of South Carolina being in a low state of health, but of sound mind memory and understanding prais'd be god forthe same do make this my last Will and testament in Manner and form following I give devise and bequeath all the lands, I am entitled to from the estate of my son John Howell Jr. my present crop, (my part or share of the negroes from Georgia, that belonged to the estate of John Howell Dec. ^d Viz. Charity and her Children) and a negro woman Rhoda and her Child Tener also my two Horses and Mule and riding Chair, and one bed and furniture that I got from John Howell's estate, to my Son William Robert Howell to him and his heirs forever he W. R. Howell paying my Debts, I also wish my Old Woman Bessa to be in the care of Robert Howell, I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Weston a negro woman named Pheby and her child Jenny, And to my grand daughter, Sarah Howell McCord I give a negro Girl named Lavinia to her to her and her lawfull issue I give devise and bequeath to to my daughter Sarah White, one negro man named Moses and one Hundred and fifty Dollars, to be paid her by my son Robert I give devise and bequeath to my grand son Thomas Richard Baldrick, son of my daughter Elizabeth Baldrick, one negro boy nam'd Carolina and to Robert Howell Baldrick a negro boy named Abraham in lieu of the share intended to give their Mother Elizabeth, my Wearing apparel etc. I wish divided between my three daughters also my bed furniture I wish equally divided between my Son W. R. Howell and my three daughters, Mary Weston, Sarah White and Elizabeth Baldrick----As there's property of my son John Howell in Georgia, and a Suit pending for the same, if its recover'd I give my Share of it to My son W. R. Howell and Robert Weston Jr. to be divided between them share and share alike, And lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my
