I Mary Phelps of Richland District in the State of South Carolina, being very weak and sick of body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God. Do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in the following form and manner that is after all my just debts are paid, I dispose of what worldly estate it has pleased God to bless me with in this life as follows, In the first place I lend unto Joel Threewits during his life time my negro fellow long Ben, girl Jude, and boy Joe, to be worked by him for his own use, excepting thirty Dollars worth of their labour per year which he is to annually put to the use of his Daughter Jermimia Williamson Threewits And at the death of the said Joel Threewits I give the above named three negroes to Jermimia Williamson Threewits and her heirs for ever-- Secondly I lend the use of my negro woman Hannah to Lucy Vaughan Loveman during her life time and at her death I give the above named wench to Joel Threewits Loveman, the Child of said Lucy V. Loveman and his heirs forever- there I give unto Thesee Ann Ross Threewits my Negro boy little Ben, to her and her heirs for ever- fourthly I give my negro boy Lewis to Epps Davis Threewits to her and her heirs for ever- fifthly I give unto my Sister Rebecca Bell my yprung black Cow with a white face, and live sows and pigs twelve in number, to her and her heirs for ever- Sixthly I give unto my Daughter Lucretia Threewits the sum of Ten Dollars to be raised out of the amount of my goods and Chatties not above disposed of-, and all the remainder of my Estate Consisting of one horse five head of Cattle household furniture etc etc etc I give to the Children of my Daughter Lucretia Therewits to be equally divided between them at the
