MARY THOMPSON.

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN.

I Mary Thompson of Richland District So Carolina being sick though of perfect mind and memory do hereby make this my last Will and Testament -----

First of all I wish my just debts paid with my funeral expences-

2ndly- Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Legrand Thompson one hundred Acres of land whereon he now lives which is to much to be detached off of my mean Track whereon I now live to him & his heirs forever,

Item 2 I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Marnea Williams wife of Eli Williams fifty Acres of Land whereon they now live (The said Eli & Marnea) To Her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath the unto my Daughter Mary Killinsworth fifty Acres of land to be surveyed & detached of my Track whereon I am now living, in such manner as will appear right in justice & my executors which land I give to her forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Harriot & to the legal Heirs of her body, fifteen Acres of Land. I do not give to be liable to the disposed of her husband James Hutson either in the payment of ~~all~~ debts or otherwise, but wholely to her & her Heirs forever,-----

Item I give demise & bequeath all the residue of my Estate both Real & Personal to be equally divided between my Son William Thompson & my Daughter Gracey Thompson after my Son having one hundred Acres of land surveye'd to him & there paying as my legacy unto my daughter Orsy Hinton five shillings to be hers & her Heirs forever.

Item I also order & direct that they pay in like manner unto my Grand Children Lewis Son of my Son Granville Thompson Dec'd Hezekiah & my Grand daughter Marnea Sister to thereabove

named Lewis & Hezekiah each five shillings to them
& their heirs forever, And as touching the residue
of my estate of every species, I give to be equally
divided between my above named Son William & Gracey
to them & their heirs forever.

Item & I ~~also~~ do hereby appoint ordain & make my Son
William Thompson & my Son inlaw Eli Williams Executors to
this my last Will & Testament revoking and denying all o
thers In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal
this 24th August In the Year of Our Lord One thousand
Eight hundred & Eighteen
