 testament that is to say, Item, I give and dispose of my
 Negroe Girl Amerley to my Nese Margaret Howell Tyson to
 her and the Heirs of her Body for ever Item, I give to my
 Nese Margaret Howell Tyson the following notes and papers
 to her her Heirs and Assigns for Ever. Viz. one note on
 Abram D Jones Exot. W. F. Goodwyn for for Hundred and fifty
 dollars dated 1. st May. 1827- one other note on Abram D Jones
 for three Hundred and five dollafs and twenty five cents
 dated 18th Oct. ^r 1826 with a credit dated the 5th Feby. 1827-
 for two Hundred dollars by an order of Jno. Roverson and
 co. one note on Henry D Taylor for one hundred and thirty
 four dollafs and fifty eight cents dated 1st March 1826.
 given to Dr. Brian Gunter but now belonging to me, one Other
 Note on William Mayson for one Hundred and Twenty dollars
 dated 22nd May 1827 together with allthe rest of my property
 whatever after paying all my Just debts and expences of my
 Burial which I wish to be in a decent and Christian Like
 manner but if my Nese Margaret Howell should die without an
 Heir of her Body then it is my desire that William Moy and
 Thomas Moy shall be the Heirs of my proper ty to shear and
 shear alike, In Witness here of I have set my hand and Seal
 this 7th day of June 1827 and fiftyfirst of American Indepen-
 dence.
