presents that I Oliver Logran of the State of South Carolina in
the District of Richland Have this day it, being the, fifteenth
day of July in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred
and seventeen By this deed of gift; convey'd confirm'd and set
over all and singular the rites and titles of my lands and pre-
mises to my well beloved Son and Daughter, namely Jacob; and
Susanah; to be equally devided between the two, also All the
rest of estate consisting of horses cattle Sheep hogs Household
furniture and Cash. this also to be divided in Like manner; them
and their Heirs; should they live to have any lawful issue, and
if either of them die without issue then, and in that case, the
property shall return to the other and should neither Jacob nor
Susanah live to have any lawful heirs of therbodys then the above
property to decend to the other heirs of my body Also I do here-
by convey and set over unto my bloved wife Elizabeth one third
of all my real and personal estate; of land stocks flocks herd
household ferniture and cash, during the term of her natural life,
and at ther death, one half of said thirds to be disposed of as
She sees fit, the other hal~~f~~ too return to Jacob legran; and
Susanah Legran the heirs of my body; If livering if not to the
other heirs of my Body. to which divison of my living I do bind
my Executors forever to prosecute after my Death in the following
manner, first divide the land; and sell the rest of the rest of
the property and divide the mony or any other way they may think
best. and to this present deed of gift; being my last will I, set
my hand and seal the day andyear first above written sign'd
