Know all men by these Presents that I Olivino Wilson, of the lower part of Richland District in the State of South Carolina Being of Sound and disposing memory; But weak in Body, and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and Being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate, as it hath pleased God, to Bless me with, Do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner following -- That is to Say-- After the Payment of all my Just Debts and funeral Expenses, I give and Bequeath the Residue or Remaining part of all the Property Both Real and Personal, which I may have in Possession, or be the rightfull owner of at my Deceased, To my two Beloved children, James Wilson and Mary Jane Wilson, and their Heirs Forever -- To Be Equally Divided between them, Share and Share alike-----

It is also my will and wish, that what Property I am may be the owner of at my deceased R Both Real and B Personal, may be Kept together for the Joint and Equal, support of the said James Wilson and Mary Jane Wilson untill the said Mary Jane Wilson Becomes of age, or gets married, in Either of which cases, She is then to have her share given up to her----- Or untill the said James Wilson gets married, in which last mentioned Event, It is then my wish for my Property Both Real and Personal to be Equally Divided Between them as aforesaid The said James Wilson, To take his share to himself, But still to Retain in his hands the possession, care and management of the said Mary Jane Wilson share, of my Property as aforesaid for her Exclusive Benefit and maintenance untill She either Becomes of age, or gets married, In either of which Events She is then to have her share of my Property, as before mentioned, Delivered up to her-----

And I the Said Olivino Wilson Do hereby appoint my son the said James Wilson, to be the Sole Executor of this my last will and
