I Penelope Wessinger being of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last will and Testament as follows.

1st. I will and desire that all my just debts be paid should leave any unpaid.

2- I will and desire that my five youngest Children to wit Samuel Coogler, Thomas Coogler, Caroline Coogler, Theodore Coogler and Frances Coogler receive the share each of them are entitled to as distributies of their Father's Jacob Coogler's state in my hands as Administratrix of said Jacob Coogler or as guardian of said minor children- I have fully paid off the elder children their shares and may be seen by a reference to the proper Offices.

3- After my debts are paid- my younger children above named paid off and the expences necessary to carry this will into execution fully settled I will and bequeath unto Jesse Wessinger the One third part of the rest and residue of my estate absolutely and forever.

4 -- I will and bequeath the two thirds of the rest and residue of my state to all my Children Share and Share alike absolutely and forever.

Should any of my Children die before me leaving issue such issue to take the portion to which such deceased child would have been entitled had the same survived me-

I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Jos. A. Black and Jesse Wessinger Executors of this my last will and Testament
