I Peter Bryce of Columbia District and State aforesaid, duly impressed with the uncertainty of human life and being at this time in feeble and declining bodily health but nevertheless of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following.

First I direct that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my Estate as soon after my decease as practicable

Item I give and bequeath, to my three younger children herein named to wit Allen, Robert, and William. Five hundred dollars each in addition to their prorata share of my Estate to aid in their education- the elder children having rec'd theirs- and Mrs Young having kindly and generously promised to take care of and provide for the education of the youngest Viz.

James Young.

Item- The residue of my Estate- which is not large- I give and bequeath share and share alike, to all my children Viz. Mary, Maria, John, Martha, Peter, Allen, Robert, William and James, to be paid to them as they attain the age of twenty one years, or to be applied by my Exrs as they may in their discretion see fit in their education, and should any of them die before they attain that age or without lawful issue, then in that case their share shall be equally divided amongst the survivors

Item.- I hereby nominate and appoint my Brother John Bryce my Nephew Campbell R. Bryce and my Son John Young Bryce Executors of this my last Will and testament with full power and authority to take into their possession all my Estate real and

personal and control the same for the uses and purposes above mentioned in as full and ample a manner as I might myself do
