I Peter Entzinger of Richland District South Carolina being weak and feeble in health but of Sound, disposing mind and memory do make and publish this as and for my last will and testament, hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

First. I desire that after my death my body be decently interred.

Second. I give devise and bequeath unto my nephew Thomas W. Entzinger all my Estate both real and personal consisting of Lands negroes, Stock of Every description all my farming tools the crops and proceeds of the crops together with all my rights or bonds, notes which I am entitled to. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my nephew Thomas W Entzinger Executor of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this the first day of August Anno Domini 1853
