sonal shall be kept together for the maintenance and sup-

port of my Wife and Children untill the youngest Child

shall arrive at the full age of twenty one years--and in

Lieu of all other dower my wife shall have her support to-

gether with my Children out of my said Estate and I do here-

by nominate and appoint my blood friends James Rowan and

John Marshall Exortors to this my last will and Testament--

hundred and twenty three--
