Hills of Richland County Being very weak in body at the same time in my ~~perfect~~ ~~mind~~ ~~memory~~ ~~and~~ ~~understanding~~ ~~and~~ ~~dall-~~ing to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that its appointed for all men once to die do make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following- First I do will that my body be decently buried at the discreession of my Executors to be hear after named Secondly Item I do will and bequarth unto James Raly Son of ann his mother now living with me the following negrows boson Sálvey and Billey and one third of the money arising from the Sale of the Lands I have now Sold as it Severally become due and one Feather bed add furniture to to be delivered o his Mother immedeately after my death Item I do will and bequarth to my will beloved Children Robt. and Jean Hills the following negrows George, Phillis Jentha, Rose hannah and Mary and the Remaining part of the money arising from the Sail of Land aforesaid as the severally become of age or Marry. I do Will and bequarth unto my well beloved Son Andrew a negro boy named Peter twelve years old. Item I do will and bequarth unto my well beloved Son John the Land and negroe he had of me and now in his possession. Item I do Will and Bequeath to Margaret Knox one Shilling Sterling, Item I do Will and bequeath unto Elizabeth Ross one Shilling Sterling. Item I do Will and bequeath unto Mary Hills one Shilling Sterling. Item I do Will that my executors do bring and carry on a ~~suit~~ ~~against~~ Robt. Knox for the recovery of Negroes he has in his possession my property at the sametime Its my Will and desire that if the negroes is recovered or If Knox shou'ds deliver up the said negroes Its my will in that case that the said negroesbe delivered to my daughter Mary as her property not with standing the aforesaid gift of one Shilling st. Item I do will that my boat be immediately

repaired the boat and live stock being pay my just debts
the boat the first sold shou'd any part of the Stocks left
that together with my household furniture and kitchen furniture
I will and bequarth to Robt. and Jane these two children only
and I do nominate constitute my well beloved Frances Joele
Adams Dannile O'Quintun and James Denton Executors of this my
last Will and Testaments.
