IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN I Robert Green of the Town of Columbia  
and State of South Carolina, being sick feeble in Body, but of  
Sound and disposing Mind and Memory, do make and ordain this  
my last Will and Testament; and first of all I give and re-  
commend my Soul to God I my Body to the Earth to be interr'd  
at the Discretion of my surviving Friends. - Item I give be-  
queath and devise to my beloved Brother Samuel Green, after  
the Death of my beloved wife Elizabeth Green all that part  
of Land on Rocky Branch and containing about fourteen Acres of  
Land be the same more or Less, the Title to which I have de-  
vived from my Father and also my Negro man Willie, to him and  
his Heirs forever. ~~and I give, bequeath and devise to my~~  
beloved Wife Elizabeth Green during natural Life the use of  
the above mention'd land, and also the said Negro Man Willis,  
I also give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Elizabeth,  
all the rest and remain of my Estate both real and personal,  
charging the same with the payment of all my just Debts, to be  
paid out of the Debts due to me and if insufficient from the  
hire of the said Negro man Willis, or any other way that my  
beloved Wife may be able to accomplish And lastly I do hereby  
nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Elizabeth Green sole  
Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament revoking all others  
In witness whereof I hereunto set my Hand and Seal at Columbia  
this Twentieth day of October in the year of our Lord one  
Thousand eight hundred and Twenty five
