4th-- I give unto my son Irvin Medlin One dollar in addition  
to what I have already given him.-----

5th--I give unto my son Isaac Medlin one dollar in addition  
to what I have already given him. -----

6th-- I give to my daughter Mary Medlin one dollar in addition  
to what I have i already given her.-----

7th-- I give unto my son Calvin Medlin all my land & household  
furniture and all my property of every kind except the Cow named  
Spot and what is other wise disposed of in this will I also give  
him the one hundred acres of land that I will to my wife during  
her life time at her death.-----

8th-- I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Medlin one dollar in  
addition to waht I have already given her.-----

9th-- I give unto my grand daughter Susanah Medlin the Cow named  
Spot -----

10th-- I do hereby appoint my son Calvin Medlin executor to this
