PETTIGREW SALISBURY

In the Name of God Amen I Pettigrew Salisbury of the State of South Carolina and Richland County Being weak in Body but of Sound and perfect Mind and Memory Thanks be Given unto God Calling to Mind the Mortallity of My Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die Do Make and ordain This My Last will and Testament that is to Say Principally and First of all I gave and Recommend my Soul to God that gave it and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be Decently Buryd In Christian Like Manner at the Dispression of My Executors hereafter Mentioned nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I Shall Recieve the same again by the mighty Power of God; and as to my wordly Estate where with it hath Pleased God to Bless me with all In this Life gave Demiss and Dispose of the Same in the following Manner and form-

First I Gave Demiss and Bequathe unto My only Son Andrew Salisbury Five Shillings to him and his heirs forever-

Secondly I Gave and bequathe to my Daughter Sarah Williams five shillings to her and her heirs forever -

I Like wise gave unto my Daughter Mary Killingsworth five shillings to her and her heirs forever- Forthly I Give and Bequathe unto my Daughter Anne Hamelton five Shillings to her and her heirs forever- Lastly I gave and bequath unto my Grandson Pettigrew McGowing one hundred pound Sterling or two young negroes over ten and under fifteen years old, and if the said Pettigrew McGowing Should Decease Before the the Said Pettigrew McGowing Should Come of age Then the Legacy of the above mentioned Shall Be Equally Divided Between the above mentioned to wit Andrew Salisbury and Sarah Williams Mary Killingsworth and Anne Hamelton and at the Decease of the Said Pettigrew Salisbury all Debts due shall be Collected and then ever Individual now in my Possession or the Said Pettigrew Salisbury -shall be Sold and Equally Divided among the above mentioned Legatied I Do further annominate and appoint My True and trusty frind Thomas
