Bailey on this condition that my wife and son Live together there life time and Keep them property in common at at the death of Either the survivors to have the whole of it but in the Event of a Separation to my Good wife I give One Half of my Estate.-----

I give to my Son Starr H. Bailey in Trust for my Grand Son Percy S Bailey if a live if not his next Eldest male child the Two acres of Land on the west side of Square in Columbia Between Lady Wayne Gervais and Pulaski Street not to be sold or disposed of until the Year of Our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty five I also Give my son Starr H. Bailey in Trust in Trust for his male Children all the Real Estate I have in Danbury Connecticut at the Death of my Sister and Brother also have a Life Estate in this Property which must Be Scrupulously Respected This Connecticut Property consist in three small places or Houses.-----

I do Hereby appoint and Legally constitute my wife Eliza S. Bailey my Executrix with my Son Starr H. Bailey and Doct John Fisher my Executors and Empower them jointly or Either One of them with Doct John Fisher To do all and Every act Relating to my Estate Real and Personal that I could do myself if I were alive and I do most Earnestly and Solemnly Enjoin on all my Executors The True and most Faithfull Execution of this my Last will and
