I Samuel Huggins of Richland District in the State of South Carolina being sick of body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to god for same, do make this my last will & testament in manner following -- I give and bequeath to my son James Huggins's son John my young mare, I have already given to my daughter Rachel Rawlinson one mare. I also give & bequeath to my beloved wife Mary huggins, the land whereon I now live my old mare all my stock of Cattle Hogs & Sheep and all my goods & chattels whatever, to her forever And I do appoint my wife, Mary Huggins Sole Executrix of this my last will & testament hereby revoking & making void all ~~my former~~ will or wills heretofore by me made & do declare this to be my last will & testament in Witness whereof I the S'd Samuel Huggins have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 18th day of Sept'r 1817

tate of John Howell as Administrator this paper was found among his Papers - that the Testator Huggins in 1832 requested Deponent to look at said Will - it was opened and read to him and he observed that it was the same Will and was perfectly satisfied with it
