SAMPSON S. WOOD

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. I Sampson S. Wood of Richland District and State of South Carolina being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory do hereby will my soul to God who gave it, and as touching the worldly goods wherewith it has pleased God to bless me I do hereby make the following disposition- first, I hereby give to my Negro Woman Phoebe her freedom Secondly, I give and Bequeath to my said negro woman Phoebe the whole of my Estate consisting of stock of various kinds Household furniture, growing Crop and debts due me. Thirdly it is my desire that my executor sell to the best advantage my negro Girl Mary, the proceeds whereof after all my just debts are paid I also give and bequeath to my negro woman Phoebe, to her and her Heirs forever. and lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my respected friend John McLomere Executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made at any time and declaring this to be my only last Will and Testament and Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21 day of July in the year of our lord 1820.
