Then I give to my Daughter Lucy Waddell after the Death
of her Husband Twenty yards of Homespun Cloth for the use
of Her and Her Children annually for ten years But if she
should Die then given to Her Children To Clothe them-----

Then I give my Grand Daughter Sally Inman if she will Come
and Live with my Wife or one of my Daughters Twelve yards
of homespun Cloth annually for five years-----

Then I ~~give~~ give to my Daughter Salley Trapp one Hundred
Dollars and my Black Horse.

Then I Lend to my Beloved wife Martha Stanley During Her
Natural life or Widow Hood the Remainder of my Estate Real
and Personal But if she should Die or Marry then it is to
Be Divided Between my four young Children Namely Robert
Hendrick William, Bird, Martha and ~~Samuel~~ Samuel-----

I Do Likewise appoint my wife Martha Stanley Together with
my & Friend Doctor Edward Fisher my Executors to this
my Last will and Testament and Do Hereby authorise and
and Empower the above Executors to Dispose of as much of my
Property if Required to Raise and Scoll my Children-----
